

• → No zigzag driving behavior for warm up of tyres from the RED LINE to the Starting Area






INFORMATION Sporting Regulation

• If a Driver starts from the Assembly Area after the intervention of a Mechanic, he will take the start from the back of the formation , irrispective of the number of the Formation Laps .



It's forbidden to overtake from Red Line to Starting Line –Yellow Line




Time penalty-Starting procedure

- For driving out of the start corridor before the lights have been switched off
- Penalty of 3 seconds for partly crossing the corridor
- Penalty of 10 seconds for completely fetting out of the corridor


ONE SINGLE LINE BEHIND THE LEADER SLOW SPEED NO OVERTAKE

GREEN FLAG OVERTAKE AFTER CROSS THE FINISH LINE










h) Each lap completed during the neutralisation will be counted as a racing lap.

FRONT FAIRING

The black flag with an orange disc will not be shown to a driver if his front fairing is no longer in the correct position.

If the judge of fact reports that the front fairing on one or more karts was no longer in the correct position when the "black and white chequered flag" was waved and the kart(s) concerned crossed the finish line, a time penalty of <u>05 seconds</u> will be imposed on the driver(s) concerned. <u>This time penalty is not susceptible to appeal.</u>


UNDER INVESTIGATION




OVERTAKING IS FORBIDDEN IN THIS AREA – Yellow / Green





SHOWS ONLY ONCE AND THE DRIVER MUST TO THE REPAIR IMMEDIATELY !







• In the case of a "WET RACE", the choice of tyres will be left to the appreciation of the Drivers; The Race Director reserving the right to use the Black Flag if the deems that a Driver's kart is fitted with the wrong set of tyres and that the Driver is too slow and dangerous for other Drivers. The use of "SLICK" tyres is therefore mandatory in any other case.
