

#### **QUALIFYING PRACTICE SESSIONS**

In accordance to the timing,

1 Qualifying Practice session
is scheduled.

(06 MINUTES)

If a Driver stops in the Repairs Area or in the Servicing Park, it will be <u>final</u>. He/she shall not be allowed to start again.



RDSS Karting 2024 - Art.17 -F Starting Grid. Access to the "Pre-Grid" will end five (5) minutes before the time scheduled for the start of the Race. Any kart which has not taken its position on the "Pre-Grid" at that moment shall not be allowed to do so.



The Race Director retains the right to suspend or stop any session - including with the use of the Red Flag - if one or more drivers are deemed to conduct themselves in an incorrect or dangerous manner which may also affect other drivers on the circuit.



#### LIMIT FOR THE MECHANICS' ASSISTANCE

#### Before the start of the Heats/Race

3 MINUTES before the scheduled start time, the Mechanics must leave the Assembly Area.





## INFORMATION Sporting Regulation

• If a Driver starts from the Assembly Area after the intervention of a Mechanic, he will take the start from the back of the formation, irrispective of the number of the Formation Laps.

#### **During Formation Lap**

•→ No stops

• > No zigzag driving behavior for warm up of tyres

No tyre warming from the RED LINE to the Starting Area



#### **FORMATION LAP - TYRE WARMING**



During the formation lap it is forbidden to overtake another Driver under pain of a penalty inflicted by the Stewards (5 seconds or disqualification from the Heat)

**SAFETY REASON** - Tire warming only is only permitted if the entire width of the track is not used

#### RDSS Karting 2024 - Norme Generali – Art.18



Pushers are not allowed to help Drivers once they have crossed the line established at the exit of the "Pre-Grid".

- If the kart is to stop on track for any reason, the Driver shall only have a singular attempt to restart, after which the kart is to be moved in a safe location.

Any unsafe rejoining of the track will be reported to the Stewards. In any case, the rejoining of the track must be done on the kart's own power and at no instance is the Driver to leave his seat to push the kart to restart


# **FORMATION LAP RED LINE**



Only when the lights are OFF you can move out of the lines




#### Time penalty-Starting procedure

For driving out of the start corridor before the lights have been switched off:

- Penalty of 03 seconds for partly crossing the corridor
- Penalty of 05 seconds for completely fetting out of the corridor







## FLAGS & INFORMATION







#### **FRONT FAIRING**

The black flag with an orange disc will not be shown to a driver if his front fairing is no longer in the correct position.

If the judge of fact reports that the front fairing on one or more karts was no longer in the correct position when the "black and white chequered flag" was waved and the kart(s) concerned crossed the finish line, a time penalty of <u>03 seconds</u> will be imposed on the driver(s) concerned. <u>This time penalty is not susceptible to appeal.</u>

Front Fairing out of the correct position during the qualifying session drop of 2 grid positions in the starting grid.







•In the case of a "WET RACE", the choice of tyres will be left to the appreciation of the Drivers; The Race Director reserving the right to use the Black Flag if the deems that a Driver's kart is fitted with the wrong set of tyres and that the Driver is too slow and dangerous for other Drivers. The use of "SLICK" tyres is therefore mandatory in any other case.
